The aim of this study is to evaluate the effects of Ginkgo Biloba Extract (GBE) in executive functionimpaired Mild Cognitive Impairment (MCI) patients by assessing gait while walking alone as well as under differing dual-task conditions. The primary endpoint in the evaluation of GBE efficacy is gait speed. The secondary endpoint is cycle time variability under dual-task conditions.
