In the last years, two major services have been cancelled in Europe: the MUR (Medication Use Review) in the UK and the PMC (Polymedikation-Check) in Switzerland, questioning the success of nationwide implementation. In this project, a strategy for the individualized implementation of services on pharmacy-level has been developed. It will be tested in community pharmacies starting new services such as vaccination or screening for covid-19.
